

Adding Scrolling Media

Adding rotating content to the main content area

Populating your main content area with default media that rotates periodically with images and video can be done quickly and easily through the template tab.

To begin, navigate to the Template tab.



Select Main Content

From the template tab, select the area you would like to begin adding videos/images to.

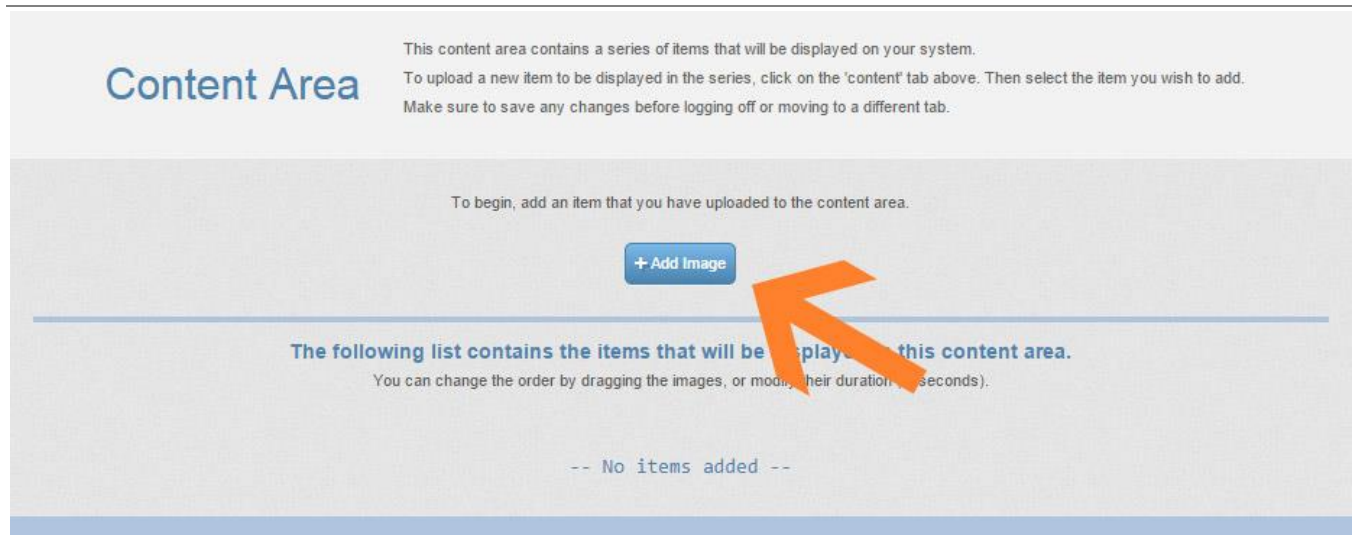

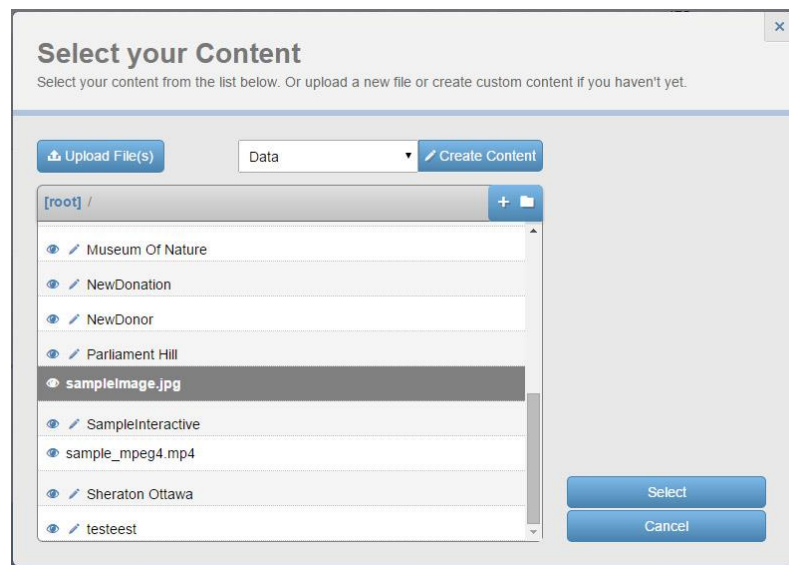

Adding Images and Video



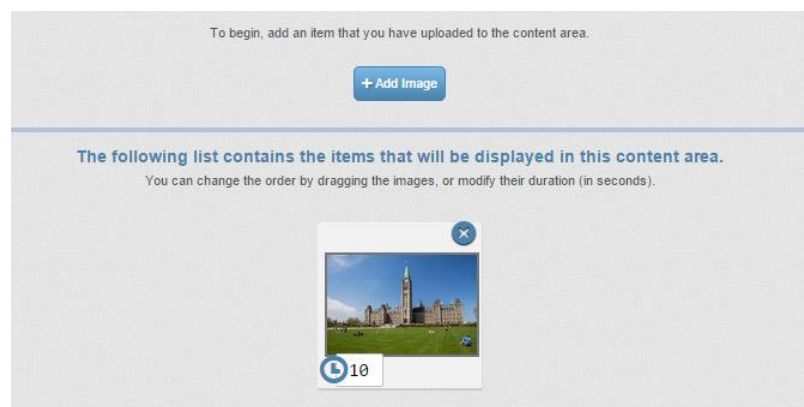
After scrolling down, click the “+Add Image” button to add an image or video to the list of rotating content.



After clicking on the Add Image button, the content uploader dialog will be displayed. You may select your content that you have uploaded previously, or upload new content and select it. For additional information on uploading content, see the How To Upload Content document.

Adjusting Content

After selecting your content it will be added to the list below. You can rearrange added items by dragging them, remove them from the list by clicking the x, and also set their display duration in seconds via the input field.



Save

After making any changes, scroll down to the bottom and click save to save any changes you have made to your list.
